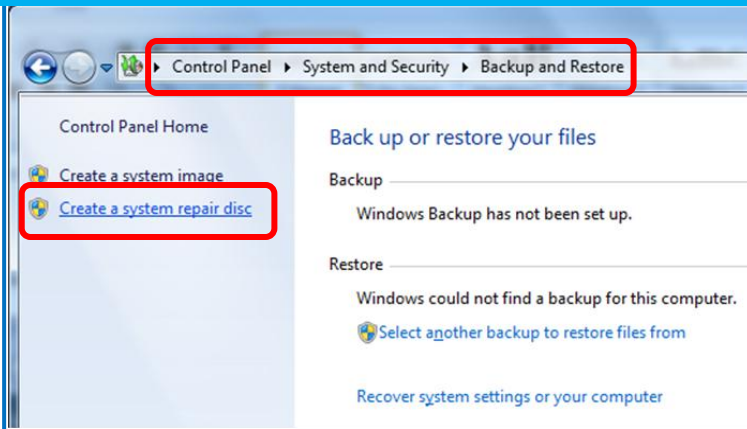


Create a Repair Disk – Windows 7



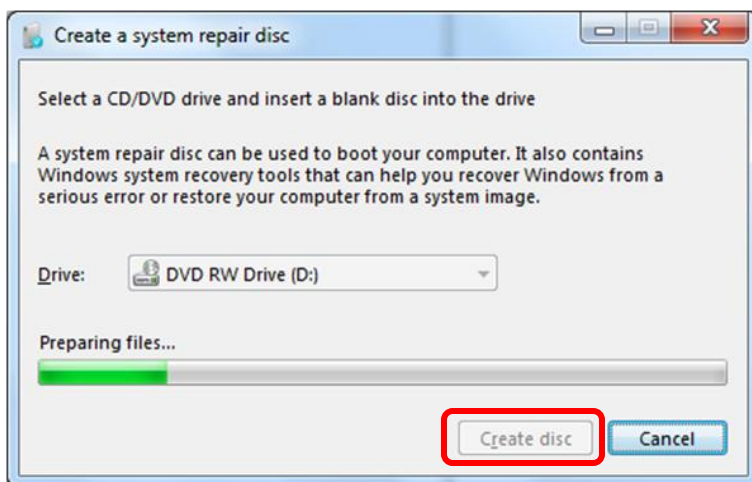
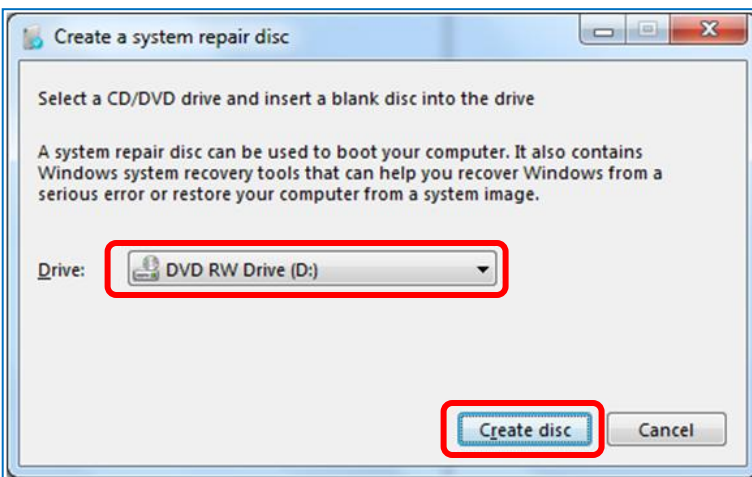
If your computer came with a Repair disk you will not need to create one.

This process will take a long time to finish so be prepared to work with it. A pack of 12 disks should be sufficient or a removable hard drive.

Be sure to read all windows, choose option needed and follow commands.

To create a System Repair Disk:

1. Go to the **Start Menu**.
2. Click on **Control Panel**
3. Click on **System and Security**
4. Click on **Backup and Restore**
5. On the **left** pane click on **Create a System Repair Disk**
6. You may be asked for a password or confirmation; type password or confirm you have administrative rights
7. **Insert a DVD** into the drive on the computer **or plug in removable hard drive**
8. **Select** the CD/DVD drive on the menu
9. Click on the **Create Disc** button and follow prompts
10. Computer will prepare files for copying to the DVD, then
11. As you need more disks, the computer will tell you to insert another disk. **Be sure to number each disk in order as you remove them from drive.**



This does not repair viruses or other malware. It is used when windows is unbootable. You will need to install an antivirus program or use online software.

To Use the Repair Disk follow these steps:

(Be sure to read all windows and follow commands).

1. Insert the system repair disc into your CD or DVD drive.
2. Restart your computer using the computer's power button.
3. If prompted, press any key to start the computer from the system repair disc.
4. Choose your language settings, and then click Next.
5. Select a recovery option, and then click Next.
