



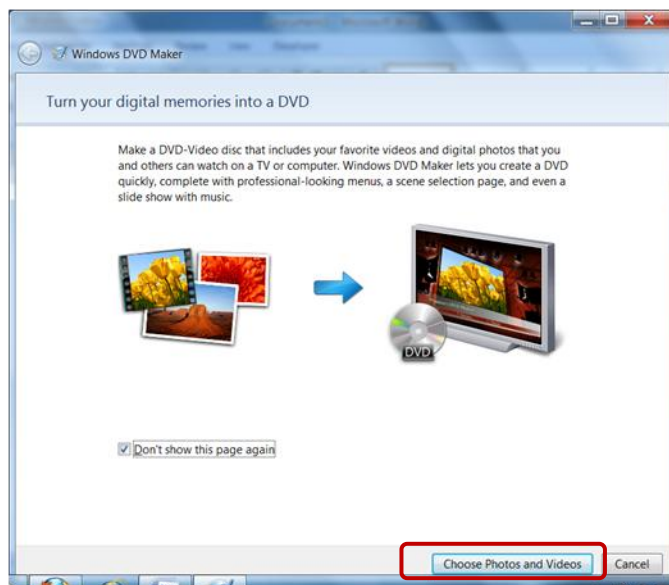

Getting Started

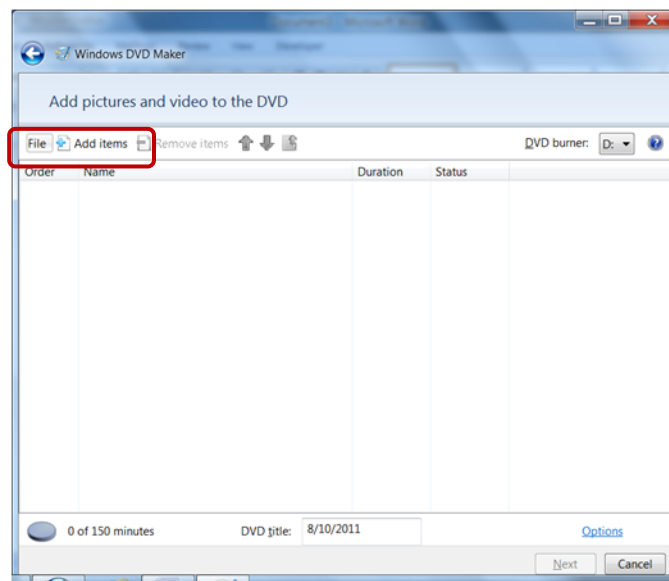
Click on the Start Menu → Click on All Programs → Click on Windows DVD Maker

*If you don't see it, type it in the search box and choose from the list provided.

1. Click on Choose Pictures and Videos



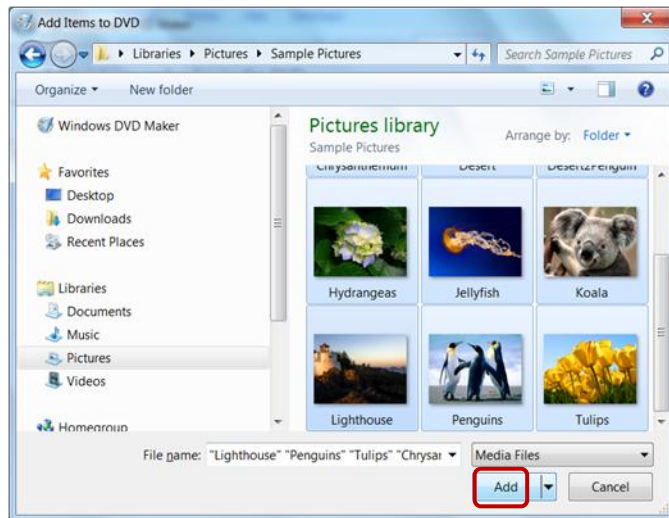
2. Click on Add items to begin a new project
3. Click on File to open existing project



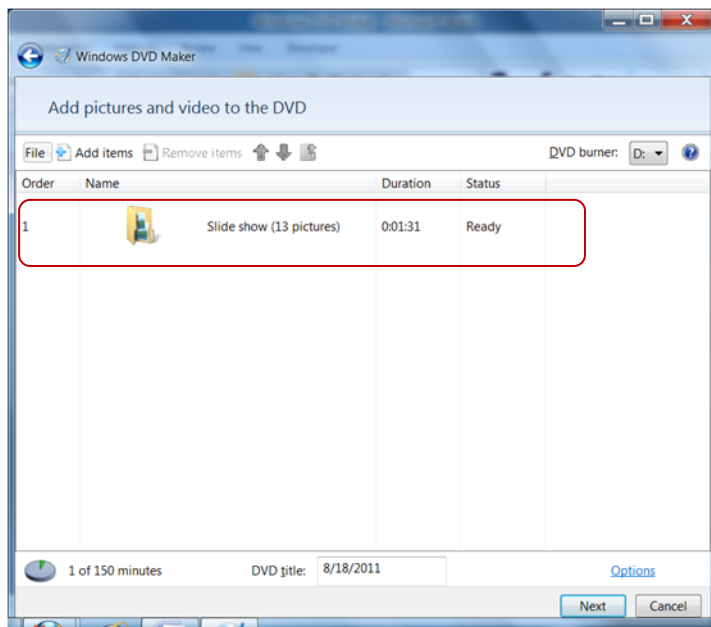


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4. Click on the Pictures or Videos library at the left to view files.



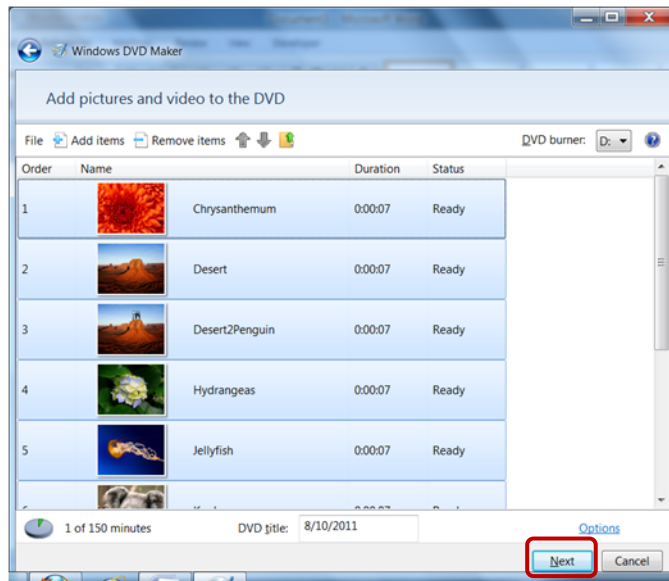
5. Click on Pictures or Videos choices
 - 🖱️ Hold the Ctrl key to select multiple pictures at the same time
 - 🖱️ If you want to select all the pictures in a file type Ctrl+A
6. Click the Add Button



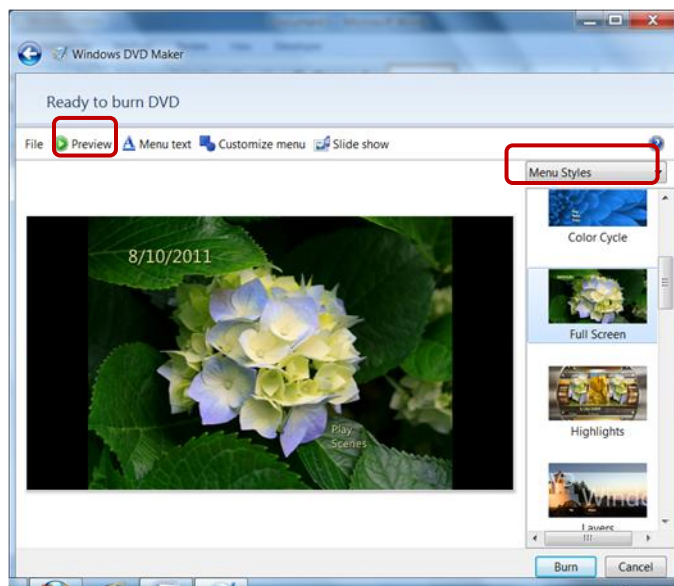
7. Double click on file to open

8. In the DVD Maker window choose pictures/videos wanted
 - ✎ Again, you can hold the Ctrl down to select a group of pictures.
 - ✎ If you want all of them use Ctrl+A.
9. Click Next



10. In the Menu Styles, click on each one until you find option you like best for your pictures/videos
 - Use the preview button to view the video

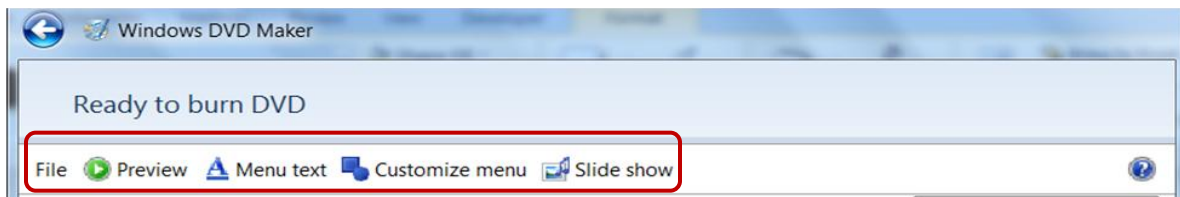


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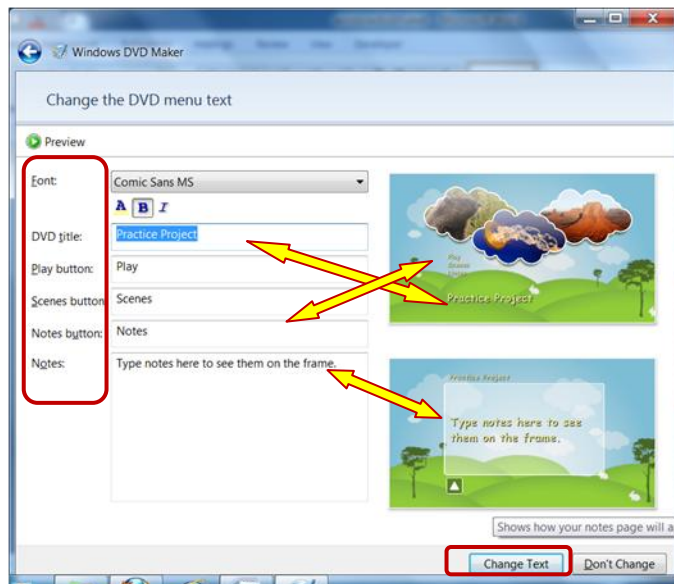
9. Click the Preview button to view
10. Click OK if you want to save it, Back if you want to change it

NOTES:

- You have the option to preview your video whenever you make changes.
- In the following windows you will return to the DVD Maker window with more options after you click on the Change button. This window is not pictured in this document each time you click on the change button. Look for the row of links under Ready to burn DVD.



11. Click Menu Text for text options: (These will be visible as you type in the top right preview)



Choose font from Font menu

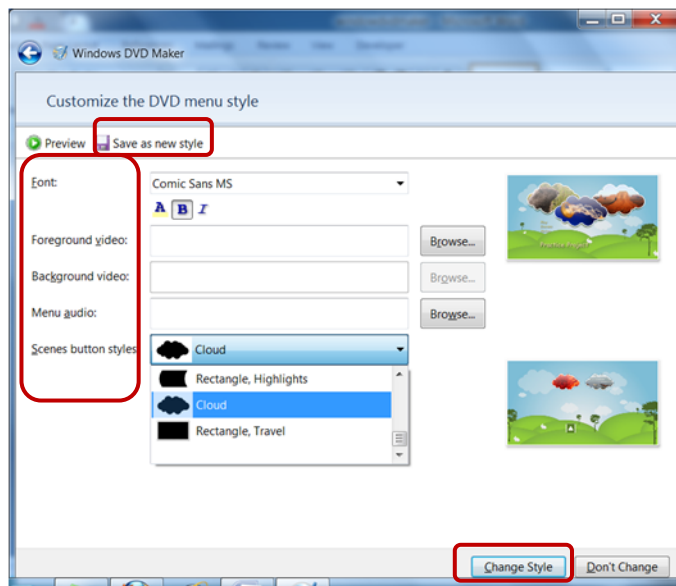

- ✎ Type DVD Title
- ✎ Play, Scenes and Notes short cut button are on the first frame;
 - to change the names, retype
 - to remove, delete
- ✎ When you type notes they will be displayed at the bottom right preview

12. Click Change Text to save

13. Click the Customize Menu



14. Browse on your computer or other saving devices for:

- ✎ Foreground video

Menu audio

Click on the appropriate Browse button to look for files on your computer or a plugged in removable storage device; then choose your file with a double click.

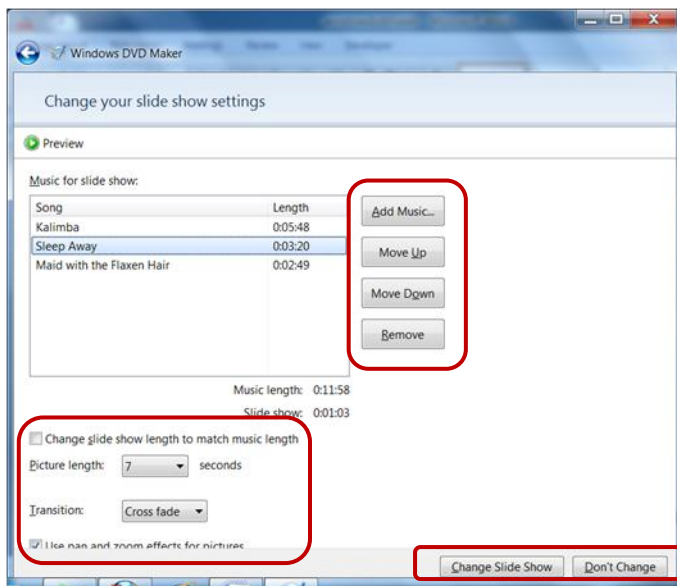
15. Click the Screen button styles to change the shape where pictures/videos will be displayed

16. Click Save as new style if you are creating your own style and want to save it

17. Click Change Style at the bottom right to save


18. Click Slide Show Settings




19. To browse for music, click Add Music

 To move the order of music if you have more than one file, click on title and use the Move Up or Move Down buttons

 To remove a title, click the Remove button

20. Click in the box to Change slide show length to match music length

--or--

21. Change slide length to change the Picture length

22. Choose the transition style from menu to change slide transition

23. Remove the check mark from the Use pan and zoom effects option if you do not want it.

24. Click on Preview before you save to view video

25. Click on Change the Slide Show button to save

26. If you want to save your file without saving to a DVD

Click on the File button

Choose Save to save as the Title

--or--

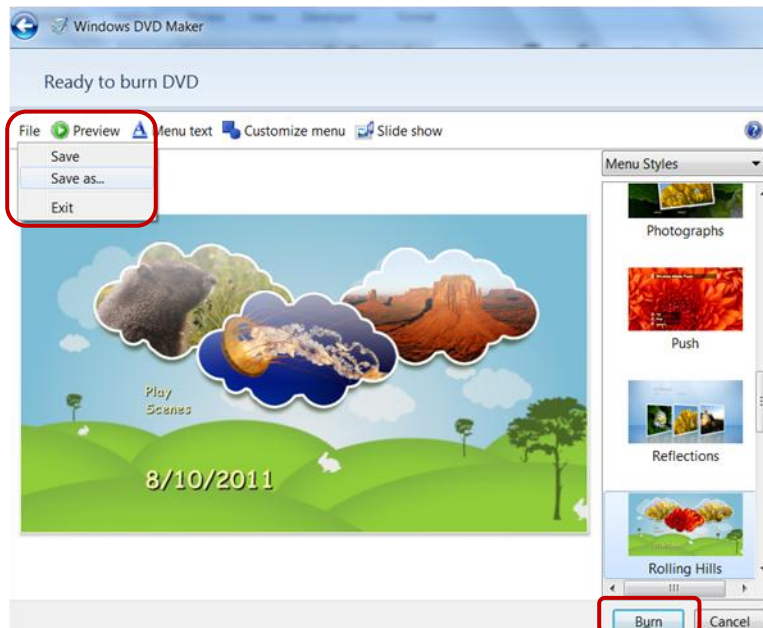
Save As to change the name of file or the folder where you want it saved

27. If your file is completely saved already

Click on Exit



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28. Name your file and save to computer or removable storage.

29. When your project is finished, place a DVD in your computer and click on Burn.

30. Follow the wizard steps to name your DVD and record onto a DVD.
